POLIGNANO

Crystal-clear waters and spectacular sea caves make Polignano a Mare unique.

It is a small town, also known as the "Pearl of the Adriatic". One of its landmarks is the remains of the *Via Traiana* in the bridge that crosses *Lama Monachile* and is still walkable today.

Polignano is a splendid medieval town, set on a high and rugged coastline. It is the hometown of Domenico Modugno, the world-famous singer known for his song *Nel blu dipinto di blu* (also known as *Volare*). The walk-through tour along the narrow streets of the old town will include spectacular views from the terraces overlooking the sea, often used as movie sets.







MONOPOLI

Monopoli, or "unique city" (from the Greek *monos* and *polis*), is a seaside town entrenched in its seafaring traditions. Its historic center, a genuine maze of narrow streets, is a marvelous blend of standard houses, sumptuous religious buildings and splendid stately palaces. *Porta Vecchia*, flanked by the city walls, is the gateway to this ancient part of Monopoli, nestled on the Adriatic Sea and dominated by the Castle. Surrounded by the sea, This iconic area was founded as a military outpost and later became a residence for nobility.
